Description

A key public realm project for Interserve Special Projects in conjunction with Sheffield City Council that will contribute to the regeneration of Sheffield City Centre in an area surrounding the Midland Railway Station and Hallam University.

The principal work content was highway improvements, utilities diversions, lighting, external paving and construction of the 'cutting edge' water feature' consisting specifically of:

- 3,500 Sq M of Yorkstone paving in walkways and ramps
- 7,000 Sq M of Chinese Granite paving in walkways and ramps
- 10,000 Sq M of Highway reconstruction
- 1,400 Lin M of Chinese Granite kerbing
- Concrete structure for water feature (85m x 12m x 5m)
- Drainage and Ducting
- Landscaping
- Feature Lighting

Paving was laid on Stientec mortar and grouted with Granotec.

The area is subject to extremely high volumes of traffic and pedestrian movements which necessitated considerable traffic and pedestrian management. To minimise disruption designated traffic and pedestrian routes were agreed with all stakeholders.
