Description

The objectives of the scheme were:

- to create a space where people will want to meet and linger
- to provide inclusive access to the main church entrance
- to mark the position of Leamington's first source of spa water
- to open up the restricted access into the churchyard
- to provide a modern slant to take the area into the future

Designed around the fact that the original source of Leamington's famous water spa occupied part of this public space the area was designed on the theme of 'water' echoed in the public art feature.

The works consisted of:

- Re-paving works to front of church
- New seating
- Semi-circular ramps and steps to give improved disabled access
- Planting
- Lighting
- Public art - a sculpture on the site where the original spring was located in Leamington Spa
